## Start your study year well prepared

Great, you're preparing for your two year master's programme with Eu-HEM! Since studying at four different universities in four different countries is more complex than 'just studying at your local university', we created this checklist to help you.

### START BY GETTING IN

We only evaluate complete applications, so make sure to provide all documents (it's a lot, we know but it's worth it).

- Download this checklist
- Apply through [eu-hem.eu](http://eu-hem.eu) (you will be redirected to [University of Oslo](http://University of Oslo))
- Provide documentation of English language proficiency
- Upload official certificate/diploma and transcript of Secondary Education
- Upload your bachelor's degree certificate and academic transcript
- Upload a copy of your passport
- Provide official translations of documents
- Write an outstanding motivation letter
- Complete the declaration form
- Provide your Curriculum Vitae
- Wait for the results of your application

### TO COMPLETE YOUR ENROLLMENT

Did you manage to get in and receive our offer? Congrats! Now you can start your actual enrollment. Make sure to complete everything, otherwise you cannot start the programme.

### TO START YOUR YEAR WELL ORGANIZED
