

Eu-HEM checklist

Start your study year well prepared

Great, you're preparing for your two year master's programme with Eu-HEM! Since studying at four different universities in four different countries is more complex than 'just studying at your local university', we created this checklist to help you. **The following checklist applies if you have submitted your application to MCI.**

START BY GETTING IN

We only evaluate complete applications, so make sure to provide all documents (it's a lot, we know but it's worth it).

Download this checklist

Apply through eu-hem.eu (you will be redirected to University of Oslo or MCI, depending on when you apply)

Provide documentation of English language proficiency

Upload official certificate/diploma and transcript of Secondary Education

Upload your bachelor's degree certificate and academic transcript

Upload a copy of your passport

Provide official translations of documents

Write an outstanding motivation letter

Accept the checkbox that you have understood the study fees when you apply via MCI

Complete the declaration form

Provide your Curriculum Vitae

At MCI you will be invited to an interview to express your motivation

Wait for the results of your application

TO COMPLETE YOUR ENROLLMENT

Did you manage to get in and receive our offer? Congrats! Now you can start your actual enrollment. Make sure to complete everything, otherwise you cannot start the programme.

Pay your participation fee to the University of Oslo (Non-EU) or Erasmus University Rotterdam (EU)

TO START YOUR YEAR WELL ORGANIZED
